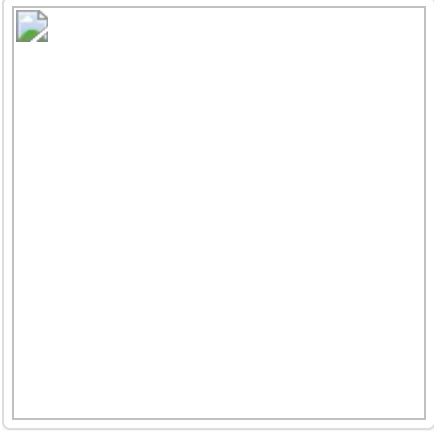




AnnaBel Ames
