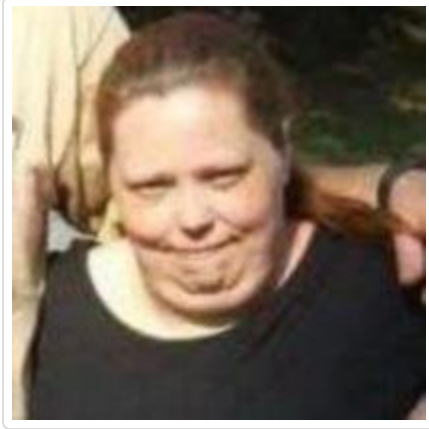




Annette Louise McMurray
