Bernard "Joe" Joseph Mudd, age 87, of Chanute, KS passed away on Saturday, October 22, 2016 in Chanute. Joe was born on August 18, 1929 on a farm near Walnut, KS the son of Theodore and Ada (Watts) Mudd.

On December 22, 1950, Joe married Estel Ann Wagner in Galesburg, KS where they lived together before moving to Chanute in 1960. Estel preceded Joe in death on May 1, 2009.

Joe grew up in rural Galesburg and graduated from Thayer High School in 1947. He worked as a Production manager for GEO Churchill for over 30 years before his retirement.
