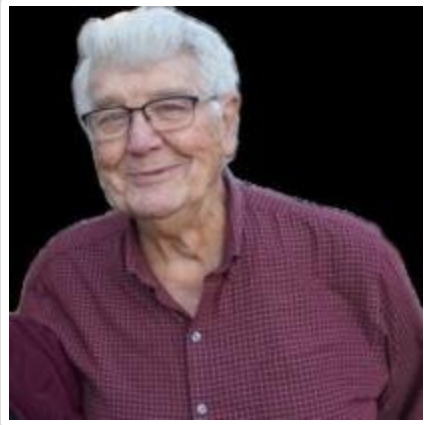




Calvin E. Howard III
