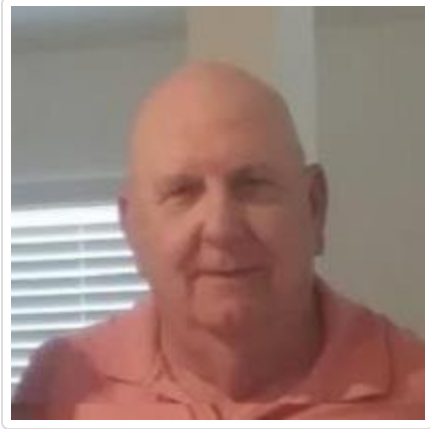




Carl Michael Shay Sr.
