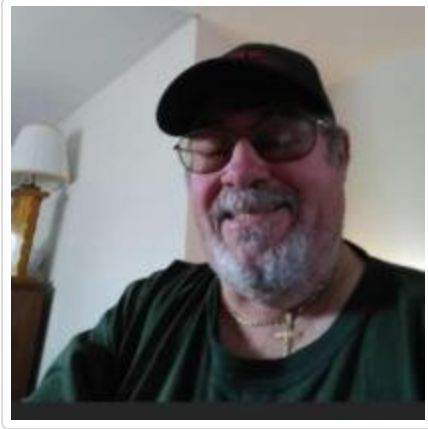




David Alan Denman
