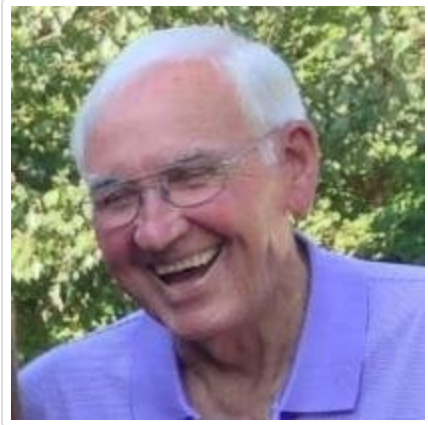




Edward Dean "Ed" Rausch
