Elaina D. Bell, 65, of Severy, KS, passed away peacefully at her home on Sunday, June 1, 2025, after a courageous battle with cancer. Born on July 16, 1959, in Ark City, KS, she was the beloved daughter of Daniel and Vergie Etta (Albert) White.

On August 30, 1980, Elaina married Terry Alan Bell. They shared 24 years together until Terry's passing on August 19, 2004. Above all, Elaina was proud of her family. She was an authentic and caring person with a beautiful soul, always able to find the good in others.

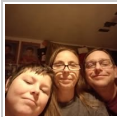
