Flora E. Erickson, age 94, of Chanute passed away on Thursday December 10, 2020 at Neosho Memorial Regional Medical Center. Flora was born on July 15, 1926 in Petrolia, KS the daughter of Earl and Mae (Larson) Edmonson.

Flora was a graduate of Oskaloosa High School class of 1944. On December 26, 1953 she married Kile K. Erickson. They were married 42 years. She and Kile lived in Chanute until Kile's retirement from the Santa Fe railroad. During their years in Chanute they raised a family of 5 children. Flora made numerous life long friends during her years in Chanute.

Flora worked as a legal secretary most of her life. She was an active member in the Chanute Chapter of Legal Secretaries until she and Kile moved to Northern California in 1978. The couple returned to Chanute in 1988 due to Kile's declining health. She worked at the Chanute Chamber of Commerce for 6 years before her retirement in 1994.
