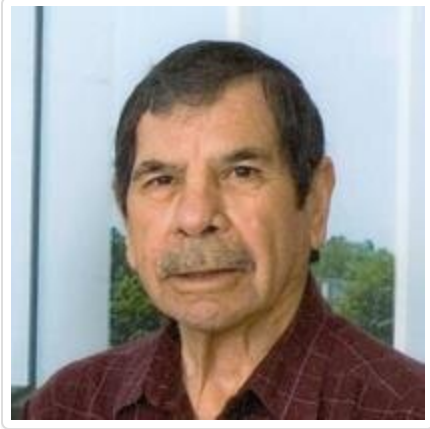




Fred Gutierrez Ysusi
