Henry Burton "Bud" Beechner, age 91 of Moline, Kansas passed away March 18, 2020 at Kansas Medical Center in Andover, Kansas

Bud was born on July 24, 1928 to Henry P. Beechner Jr. and Margaret J. McClintock in Moline, Kansas. He attended elementary school in Butler, Missouri until the family returned to Moline. His education was continued at Moline Elementary and graduated from Moline High School with the class of 1946. He was a proud member of the Moline High School Alumni Association.

He enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1948. He served on various ships, overseas stations, as well as stations in the continental United States. He retired from the Navy after reaching the rank of Chief Petty Officer.
