Herbert "Chick" H. Shores, 77, of Chanute, KS, passed away after a lengthy illness on June 13, 2017, at St. Francis Hospital in Wichita, KS.

Herbert was born October 14, 1939, the son of Herbert and Vivian Lee (Taylor) Shores, in Kansas City, KS. He married Judy (Fulps) Shores at the Nazarene Church in Chanute in 1958 and they enjoyed 58 years of marriage. She survives him at their home.
