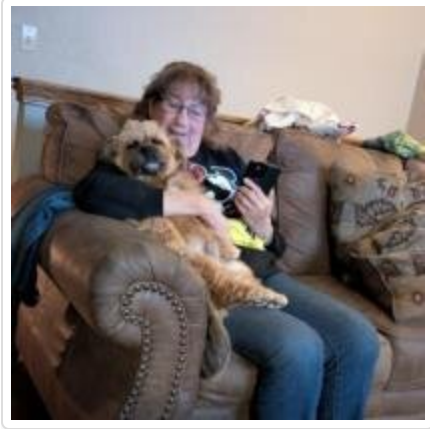




JoAnn Marie Turner

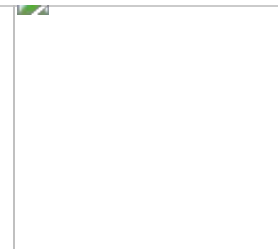
