He was grinning from ear to ear, he started reading, and the tears started. He was pretty pleased with the encouraging letter from Christopher Reeves and I was glad to see him happy in that moment. To the family of Mike, you had a wonderful person there, everyone liked him. He will be missed I'm sure. But I keep thinking he is up there in heaven with "Superman" and grinning from ear to ear.
