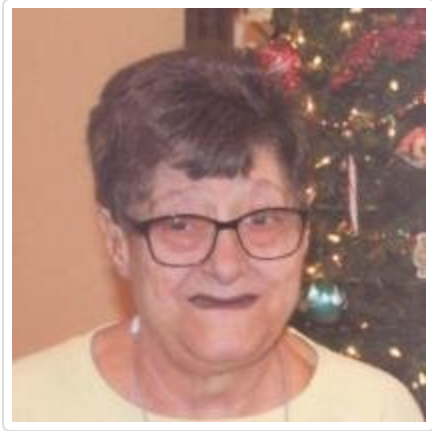




Laura Alice Ogle
