However, that was the initiation to be in the club. All by Mitch's design. Sheke-deke was the safe word for my kids when they were little. If anyone could say Sheke-deke they were safe to get in the car and ride home with. These last few years I spoke with Mitch pretty much daily. He loved the Lord and we usually wound our conversations up with what and who he needed to add to his already long prayer list. He prayed for all his nieces, nephews and cousins. He could call each of you by name. Mitch led a very meager, humble life but he so wanted to live, he was pretty amazing. I will surely miss him.

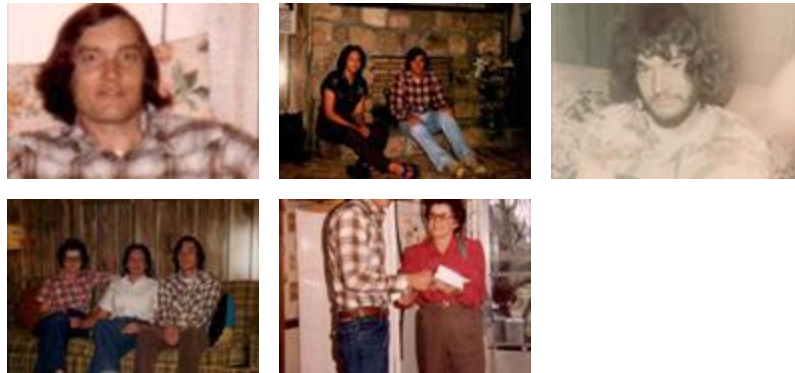
