Pat was a 23 year Breast Cancer survivor. She was a very strong willed woman and was strong in her faith. She would share her faith with all she met and instilled it in all of her family. She always put everyone else's needs before her own and she was the solid rock that held everything together in the good times and the bad. Pat's favorite times were the ones that she spent with her family. Pat and Bill were lifelong members of St. Patrick Catholic Church.
