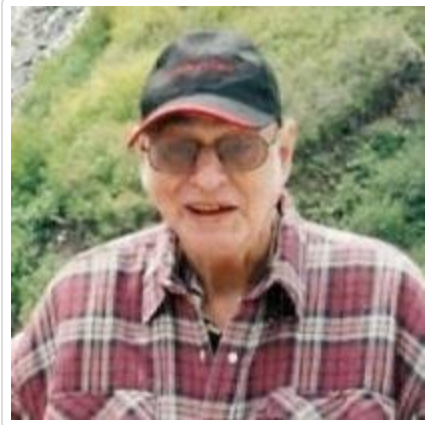




William Riley VanHouten
